We will be serving drinks throughout the morning and sausages in a bun for our volunteers. The gates will be open from 10am until noon.

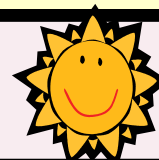
Please could you sign at the volunteer sheet at the front office if you and your children will be coming along so that we can provide enough food for everyone.
